**General Description:**

This joint resolution of the Legislature encourages state and local government changes to remove barriers to family agricultural production.

*Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

WHEREAS, the family farm is a staple of American and Utah history and culture and enjoys a long tradition of agricultural production;

WHEREAS, the values and advantages of youth and family participation in agriculture enterprises are well known to include responsibility, discipline, independence, husbandry skills, and family unity;

WHEREAS, family farm production diversifies the food supply and builds local economies; and



WHEREAS, family farm operations have dramatically decreased in the last several decades:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Utah encourages the Utah Department of Agriculture and Food and each of Utah's counties, cities, and towns to explore and implement changes ~~H→~~ [or exceptions] ~~←H~~ to regulations and laws to ~~H→~~ [remove barriers to] encourage ~~←H~~ family agricultural production, processing, and distribution to customers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Utah Department of Agriculture and Food, the Utah Association of Counties, the Utah League of Cities and Towns, and to each Utah State University Extension office.
