Section 1. Section **53A-1-611** is amended to read:

26	53A-1-611. Standards and assessment processes to measure student performance
27	Basic skills competency test.
28	(1) The Legislature recognizes the need for the State Board of Education to develop
29	and implement standards and assessment processes to ensure that student progress is measured
30	and that school boards and school personnel are accountable.
31	(2) (a) In addition to its responsibilities under Sections 53A-1-603 through 53A-1-605.
32	the State Board of Education, through the state superintendent of public instruction, shall
33	design a basic skills competency test to be administered in the tenth grade.
34	(b) A student must pass the basic skills competency test, in addition to the established
35	requirements of the state and local board of education of the district in which the student
36	attends school, in order to receive a [basic] value-added high school diploma of graduation.
37	(c) The state board shall include in the test, at a minimum, components on English
38	language arts and reading and mathematics.
39	(d) A student who fails to pass all components of the test may not receive a [basic]
40	value-added high school diploma but may receive a [certificate of completion] high school
41	diploma or alternative completion diploma under rules made by the State Board of Education

43	[(e)] <u>(3)</u> The state board shall make rules:

45	[(ii)] (b) that take into account and are consistent with federal law relating to students
46	with disabilities in the administration of the test[-];
47	(c) that provide for reciprocity in awarding value-added diplomas for a student who
48	passed a high school exit exam in another state;
49	(d) that provide for adult education students to participate in administrations of the
50	basic skills test; and
51	(e) that provide for an adult education student who exited the public education system
52	and passed the GED test to receive a high school diploma that states the student passed a basic
53	skills test.
54	[(3)] (4) The state board shall implement the tenth grade basic skills competency test,
55	no later than the beginning of the 2003-04 school year.
