Section 1. Section 16-6a-711 is amended to read:
16-6a-711. Voting entitlement generally.
(1) Unless otherwise provided by the bylaws:

(a) only voting members shall be entitled to vote with respect to any matter required or permitted under this chapter to be submitted to a vote of the members;
(b) all references in this chapter to votes of or voting by the members shall be considered to permit voting only by the voting members; and
(c) voting members shall be entitled to vote with respect to all matters required or permitted under this chapter to be submitted to a vote of the members.
(2) Unless otherwise provided by the bylaws, each member entitled to vote shall be entitled to one vote for each share issued on each matter submitted to a vote of members.
(3) Unless otherwise provided by the bylaws, if a membership stands of record in the names of two or more persons, the membership's acts with respect to voting shall have the following effect:

## (a) if only one votes, the act binds all; and

(b) if more than one votes, the vote shall be divided on a pro-rata basis.
