28 Section 1. Section **67-5-21** is enacted to read: 29 67-5-21. Attorney General Donations Account -- Gifts, grants, devises, donations, 30 and bequests to the Office of the Attorney General -- Uses. 31 (1) There is created within the General Fund a restricted account known as the 32 Attorney General Donations Account. 33 (2) The Attorney General Donations Account consists of gifts, grants, devises, 34 donations, and bequests of real property, personal property, or services from any source made 35 to the Office of the Attorney General, which gifts, grants, devises, donations, and bequests 36 shall then become the property of the state. 37 (3) Upon appropriation by the Legislature, monies from the account shall be used as 38 follows: 39 (a) if the donor designates a specific purpose or use for the gift, grant, devise, donation, 40 or bequest, it shall be used solely for that purpose; and 41 (b) gifts, grants, devises, donations, and bequests not designated under Subsection 42 (3)(a) shall be used to carry out the duties of the Office of the Attorney General under this 43
