2122	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the state of Utah:		
23	Section 1. HR-20.05 is amended to read:		
24	HR-20.05. Duties of the Speaker.		
25	(1) The general duties of the Speaker are to:		
26	[(1)] (a) assign responsibilities to and supervise the officers and employees of the		
27	House;		



28	[(2)] (b) assign places and determine access for news media representatives;	
29	[(3)] (c) call the House to order at the time scheduled for convening, and proceed with	
30	the daily order of business;	
31	[(4)] (d) announce the business before the House in the order it is to be acted upon;	
32	[(5)] (e) receive and submit in the proper manner all motions and proposals presented	
33	by Representatives;	
34	[(6)] (f) put to a vote all questions which arise in the course of proceedings, and	
35	announce the results of the vote;	
36	[(7)] (g) enforce the rules of order during debates;	
37	[(8)] (h) enforce observance of order and decorum;	
38	[(9)] (i) inform the House on any point of order or practice;	
39	[(10)] (j) receive and announce to the House any official messages and	
40	communications;	
41	[(11)] (k) sign all acts, orders, and proceedings of the House;	
42	[(12)] (1) appoint the members of committees;	
43	[(13)] (m) represent the House, declaring its will and obeying its commands; and	
44	[(14)] (n) sign or authorize a designee to sign all requisitions on the Division of	
45	Finance to pay House expenses. The Speaker shall give final approval of all expenditure	
46	requests as authorized by the majority and minority leaders of the House. These include per	
47	diem compensation and travel expenses and in-state and out-of-state travel on legislative	
48	business.	
49	(2) If the Legislature is involved in negotiating a settlement agreement that may be	
50	submitted to the Legislature according to the provisions of Title 63, Chapter 38b, State	
51	Settlement Agreements, the Speaker shall:	
52	(a) notify the House majority leader and House minority leader about the negotiations;	
53	<u>and</u>	
54	(b) appoint at least one representative from each political party to represent the House	
55	in the negotiations.	
56	Section 2. Effective date.	
57	This resolution takes effect upon approval by a constitutional majority vote of all	
58	members of the House of Representatives.
