23	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
24	Section 1. Section 10-3-1003 is amended to read:
25	10-3-1003. Civil service commission Number, term, vacancies.
26	(1) (a) A city of the first or second class may establish a civil service commission
27	under this part.
28	(b) A city that establishes a civil service commission under this part [before January 1,
29	2001] may [not] dissolve the civil service commission.

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- 30 (2) Each civil service commission under this part shall consist of three members
 31 appointed by the city legislative body.
- 32 (3) (a) The term of office of commission members shall be six years, but members
- 33 shall be appointed so that the term of office of one member shall expire on the 30th day of June
- 34 of each even-numbered year.
- 35 (b) If a vacancy occurs in the civil service commission, it shall be filled by
- 36 appointment by the city legislative body for the unexpired term.
