28	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
29	Section 1. Study Final report.
30	(1) The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee shall
31	review and make recommendations on the environmentally sound management of waste from
32	electronic products, including:
33	(a) an electronic waste recycling fee;
34	(b) the dismantling and recycling market, infrastructure, and capacity; and
35	(c) the development of public education and information.
36	(2) The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee shall
37	prepare a final report on issues described under Subsection (1) before November 30, 2006.
38	(3) The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee may hold
39	up to two additional meetings during the 2006 interim to complete the study and report
40	required under this section.
41	Section 2. Appropriation.
42	There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 2005-06 only:
43	(1) \$2,850 to the Senate to pay for the compensation and expenses of senators on the
