## **State Impact**

Provisions of this resolution changes the automatic allowance for lodging to those that necessitate lodging for the annual general session. It is estimated that 75 Legislators would likely not require lodging for the general sessions. It is estimated that provisions of this bill would reduce budgets by \$270,000. Reductions would be \$75,600 from the Senate and \$194,400 from the House of Representatives.
