Mr. President:

The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 13, COMMON POLLING PLACES AMENDMENTS**, by Representative D. Aagard, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 42 through 47:*

- 42 (2) (a) The county legislative body shall alter or divide voting precincts so that each
43 voting precinct contains not more than [1,000] {~~2,000~~} 1,250 active voters.
44 (b) The county legislative body shall:
45 (i) identify those precincts that may reach [1,000] {~~2,000 active voters or~~
become} the limit of active voters in a precinct under Subsection (2)(a) or that
becomes too
46 large to facilitate the election process; and
47 (ii) divide those precincts before February 1.
