Mr. President:

The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 13**, COMMON POLLING PLACES AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. Aagard, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 42 through 47:
 - 42 (2) (a) The county legislative body shall alter or divide voting precincts so that each
 - voting precinct contains not more than $[\frac{1,000}{2,000}]$ $\frac{1,250}{2,000}$ active voters.
 - 44 (b) The county legislative body shall:
 - 45 (i) identify those precincts that may reach [1,000] {2,000 active voters or become} the limit of active voters in a precinct under Subsection (2)(a) or that becomes too
 - 46 large to facilitate the election process; and
 - 47 (ii) divide those precincts before February 1.
