The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 220**, CHILD PROTECTION - GANG ASSOCIATION, by Representative E. Hutchings, with the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Lines 18a through 18e

House Floor Amendments 2-9-2006:

- 18a { permits the parent's child to associate with a gang while the gang, or any member
- 18b <u>of the gang, is engaged in criminal conduct in the presence of the minor, or associates</u> with a
- 18c gang in the presence of the parent's child while the gang, or any member of the gang, is
- 18d engaged in criminal conduct in the presence of the child; and
- 18e knew or should have known that the conduct described above was occurring; } ←Ĥ
- 2. Page 5, Lines 126a through 126j

corrected - House Floor Amendments 2-9-2006:

126a {<u>(I) (Aa) permits the parent's child to associate with a gang while the gang, or any</u>

126b member of the gang, is engaged in criminal conduct in the presence of the child; and
