Mr. Speaker:

The Retirement and Independent Entities Committee reports a favorable recommendation on H.B. 225, POST RETIREMENT EMPLOYMENT, by Representative G. Donnelson, with the following amendments:

- 1. *Page 1, Lines 15 through 16:* 15 extends the period that a retiree may not be reemployed from six months to 12 **16** months in order to avoid reemployment restrictions for retirees; Page 1, Lines 20 through 21: 20 Other Special Clauses: 21 {None} This bill takes effect on July 1, 2006. Page 2, Lines 46 through 47: (4) A retiree of an agency who is reemployed on a full-time basis by the same agency 46 47 within  $\{+\}$  six  $\{+\}$  $\{-\frac{12}{12}\}$  months of the date of retirement is subject to the following: Page 3, Lines 60 through 73:
- - 60 (5) A retiree of an agency who is reemployed by the same agency within  $\{+\}$  six  $\{+\}$ {<del>-12</del>-}
  - 61 months of retirement on a less than full-time basis by the same agency is subject to the
  - 62 following:
  - (a) the retiree may earn, without penalty, compensation from that position which is 63 not
