Mr. Speaker:

The Retirement and Independent Entities Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 327**, PUBLIC EMPLOYER BENEFIT PLANS, by Representative L. Christensen, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 16:
  - 15 allows a public employer to offer optional {-supplemental } benefit plans to cover
  - 16 additional persons if the supplemental benefit:
- 2. Page 1, Lines 23 through 24:
  - 23 • {-supplemental } benefit plans may not be established or offered through an order or
  - 24 action of a public employer's chief executive officer.
- 3. Page 2, Lines 43 through 45:
  - 43 (1) "Dependents" means an employee's or eligible retiree's:
  - 44 (a) current spouse; and
  - 45 (b) children, including stepchildren {-and-} , legally adopted children , and children for whom the employee or eligible retiree is a legal guardian .
- 4. Page 3, Lines 59 through 60:
  - 59 (2) A public employer may also offer optional {-supplemental} employee benefit plans that cover a
  - 60 person not described under Subsection (1) if the benefit:
- 5. Page 3, Lines 70 through 72:







- 70 (3) {Supplemental benefit } Employee benefit plans that cover a person not described under Subsection (1)
- 71 may not be established or offered through an order or action of a public employer's chief
- 72 <u>executive officer.</u>
