The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 339**, COMMISSION ON CIVIC AND CHARACTER EDUCATION, by Representative L. Christensen, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 46:
 - 46 (2) The commission consists of { five } seven members appointed as follows:
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 51 through 53:*
 - 51 (d) { the superintendent of public instruction, or a designee } of the State Board of Education, appointed by the chair ; { and }
 - (e) one member of the State Board of Regents, appointed by the chair;
 - (f) one member of the public with expertise in the area of civic and character education appointed by the other members of the commission to serve for a two year term; and
 - 52 { (g) one justice of the Supreme Court or one appellate court judge appointed by the
 - 53 Supreme Court.
- 3. Page 3, Lines 84 through 86:
 - 84 (2) provide leadership to the state's continuous focus on civic and character education
 - 85 <u>in the public schools</u> <u>and institutions of higher education</u> <u>and make</u> recommendations to local school boards and school
 - 86 administrators.
