Mr. Speaker:

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 361**, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AMENDMENTS, by Representative R. Wheeler, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 15, Lines 446 through 448
  - 446 (2) A person may not operate and an owner of an off-highway vehicle may not give
  - another person permission to operate an off-highway vehicle on any public land
    - $\{+\}$  which  $\{-\}$  is
  - 448 {+} **closed** {+} {**not designated open**} to off-highway vehicles.
- 2. Page 16, Lines 464 through 465
  - 464 (c) The division may purchase { land } or exchange federal or state

    managed lands if the purchase is approved by the Legislature in an
  - appropriations act.
- 3. Page 41, Lines 1250 through 1254
  - 1250 An action may be brought within six years:
  - (1) for the mesne profits of real property;
  - (2) upon any contract, obligation, or liability founded upon an instrument in writing,
  - except those mentioned in Section 78-12-22[-]; and
  - 1254 (3) to recover <u>fire suppression</u> costs <u>or other damages</u> caused by wildland <u>fire.</u>
