Mr. President:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 56**, SECONDARY SCHOOL AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. C. Buttars, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 54 through Page 3, Line 59:
  - 54 (1) (a) A public school shall accept credits awarded to a student by a school accredited
  - or approved by the State Board of Education or recognized by the
  - 56 <u>U.S. Department of Education</u>} <u>by the Association of Accredited Schools</u> <u>as</u> either core curriculum or elective credit, except as provided
  - 57 <u>in Subsection (1)</u> { <u>(b)</u>} <u>(c)</u> .

    (b) A public school shall accept credits from supplemental education providers and other credit sources with written approval from the student's principal or designee.
  - 58 ( (b) (c) Credits awarded for a core curriculum course shall be applied to fulfilling core
  - 59 <u>curriculum requirements, if the course is substantially aligned with the standards and objectives</u>
