The Workforce Services and Community and Economic Development Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 112**, CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE AMENDMENTS, by Senator T. Hatch, with the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 16:

12 ▶ recommends that the governor consider the allocation of economic development
13 funds for Centers of Excellence to be matched by industry and federal grants on at
