NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO THE RULES COMMITTEE

February 21, 2006

Mr. President:

The Transportation and Public Utilities and Technology Committee has returned **S.B. 227**, RESPONSIBILITIES OF PUBLIC TRANSIT DISTRICTS, by Senator S. McCoy, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 14 through 15:
 - requires a public transit district to assist and coordinate with other state agencies to
 - 15 help recipients of public assistance { find employment } to overcome transportation barriers to employment and utilize public transportation to seek and maintain employment; and
- 2. *Page 3, Lines 72 through 73:*
 - 72 (3) A public transit district incorporated under this part shall assist and coordinate with
 - other state agencies to help recipients of public assistance { find employment } (a) overcome transportation barriers to employment; and (b) utilize public transportation to seek and maintain employment .
