Mr. President:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.J.R. 9**, RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN RELIGIOUS EXPRESSIONS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS, by Senator P. Hellewell, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 42 through 45: {-
 - 42 WHEREAS, courts have ruled that voluntary student participation in prayer in public
 - 43 schools is permitted if the policy permitting it ensures that there is no direct or indirect
 - 44 coercion and no identification with a particular religion, and that the prayer should be
 - 45 nonsectarian, nondenominational, and nonproselytizing in character; }

WHEREAS, courts have upheld the right of students to spontaneously pray in school settings, and school administrators and teachers are in no way permitted to discourage religious expression, including prayer, by a student;

<u>WHEREAS</u>, in the classroom, instruction covering religious subject matter is permitted, provided the teacher does not advocate religion in general or one or more religions in particular;
