The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 202**, FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENT AMENDMENTS, by Representative N. Hendrickson, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 39 through 48:*

- 39           (2) (a) The number of foreign exchange students that may be counted for the purpose  
40 of apportioning state monies shall be the lesser of:  
41           [(a)] (i) four times the number of foreign exchange students:  
42           [(+)] (A) enrolled in the school district or charter school; and  
43           [(+)] (B) sponsored by an exchange student agency approved by the district's local  
44 school board or charter school's governing board; or  
45           [(b)] (ii) four times the number of students that have withdrawn from the school district or  
46 charter  
47 school to participate in a foreign exchange program in a foreign country.  
47           (b) Notwithstanding the limitation of Subsection (2)(a)(ii), {a} four foreign exchange  
48 {student} students  
may be counted for the purpose of apportioning state monies if the corresponding student that
