**H.B. 248      Executive and Legislative Coordination Act (Rep. D. Hogue)**

1. *Page 2, Lines 44 through 46:*

44            (2) A state agency shall directly notify each legislator of any agency-related event that:

45            (a) directly {~~impacts the citizens~~} involves a substantial group of individuals within the community or the community as a whole within the legislator's district; or

46            (b) takes place within the legislator's district.

The motion to amend passed unanimously.
