

1st Sub. H.B. 107
FULL-DAY KINDERGARTEN

Representative **Kory M. Holdaway** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 67:*

- 58 (a) may not require a student to participate in full-day kindergarten; ~~{and}~~
59 (b) shall continue to offer part-day kindergarten for students not participating in the
60 program ~~{.}~~ ; and
 (c) shall continue to honor the provisions of any preexisting contractual agreement related to other
 early intervention programs offered at the school site, through the remaining term of the contract.
61 (4) A charter school or school district that receives funds under this part shall:
62 (a) annually conduct a kindergarten readiness assessment for incoming kindergarten
63 students prior to the beginning of the school year;
64 (b) ensure that:
65 (i) ~~{at least 85%}~~ a majority of students enrolled in a full-day kindergarten class under this
 part are
66 students who have the greatest need for additional instruction, as determined by the
67 kindergarten readiness assessment; and
