- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 17:
 - 13 This bill:
 - 14 **•** provides that military personnel and their immediate family members are entitled to
 - 15 resident student status if they:
 - had Utah residency immediately prior to their active duty status <u>and did not establish</u> residency in another state for tax purposes ; and
 - reestablish residency in Utah.
- 2. Page 2, Lines 50 through 53:
 - 50 (b) Military personnel who had Utah residency immediately prior to their active duty
 - 51 <u>status and</u> <u>did not establish residency in another state for tax purposes</u> who reestablish residency in Utah upon the termination of active duty status are
 - 52 entitled to resident status for themselves and the immediate members of their families residing
 - 53 with them for tuition purposes.
