# HOME SCHOOL AND DUAL ENROLLMENT AMENDMENTS

AMENDMENT 2

Senator Mark Madsen proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 5, Lines 135 through 139:*

- 135           (g) To demonstrate a home school student's compliance with scholastic eligibility  
136 requirements, the individual providing the primary instruction of a home school student shall  
137 submit a written statement that indicates:  
138           (i) the student is mastering the material in each course or subject being taught; {and}  
139           (ii) the student is maintaining satisfactory progress towards advancement or promotion {.   **; and**  
**(iii)(A) the student is performing at or above the grade level corresponding to the student's age; or**  
**(B) the student was performing below grade level when withdrawn from a public school and is**  
**making satisfactory progress towards achieving grade level standards.**

2. *Page 5, Lines 143 through 147:*

- 143           (i) A public school student who has been declared to be academically ineligible to  
144 participate in an extracurricular activity and who subsequently enrolls in a home school shall  
145 lose eligibility for participation in the extracurricular activity until the {commencement of the  
146 next season or cycle of the extracurricular activity for which the student was academically  
147 ineligible.}   **student:**  
**(A) demonstrates academic eligibility by providing test results or a portfolio of the student's work;**  
**(B) returns to public school and reestablishes academic eligibility; or**  
**(C) enrolls in a private school and establishes academic eligibility.**

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
