RESTITUTION AMENDMENTS

Senator **Gregory S. Bell** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 14:*

11 Highlighted Provisions:

12 This bill:

▶ requires the full amount of court ordered restitution be paid:

• before a person can be eligible for an expungement, and

• before a court can enter a conviction to the next lower degree of a criminal offense; and

13 ▶ requires a petitioner to pay the full amount of restitution ordered by a court for the

14 criminal conviction for which the person is seeking an expungement.

2. *Page 2, Lines 47 through 50*

Senate Committee Amendments
