during the license cycle, complete 16 hours of qualified continuing professional
education; and
 provides that the required hours of continuing education may be proportionately
increased or decreased if a renewal period is extended or shortened by the Division
of Occupational and Professional Licensing.

- 33 qualified continuing professional education in accordance with standards defined by rule.
- 34 (2) If a renewal period is extended or shortened under Section 58-3a-303, the division
- 35 shall proportionately increase or decrease the continuing education hours required for licensure
- 36 <u>renewal under this section.</u>
