LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies the Motor Vehicles Code by amending driving by minors provisions.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

▸ repeals the nighttime driving restriction for persons younger than 17 years of age;

and

▸ repeals the passenger limitation provisions for certain minor drivers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Repealer.**

This bill repeals:

Section **41-8-2**, Operation of vehicle by persons under 17 during night hours



28 **prohibited -- Exceptions.**

29 Section **41-8-3, Operation of vehicle by persons under 16 and six months --**

30 **Passenger limitations -- Exceptions -- Penalties.**
