LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies the State System of Public Education Code by authorizing the use of appropriations for accelerated learning programs for International Baccalaureate programs.

Highlighted Provisions:

AMENDS:

53A-17a-120, as last amended by Chapter 320, Laws of Utah 2003

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53A-17a-120** is amended to read:

53A-17a-120. Appropriation for accelerated learning programs.



28 (1) Money appropriated to the State Board of Education in Section 53A-17a-104 for
29 accelerated learning programs shall be allocated to local school boards for the following
30 programs:

- 31 (a) programs in grades 1-12 for the gifted and talented;
- 32 (b) concurrent enrollment; [~~and~~]
- 33 (c) advanced placement[~~;~~]; and
- 34 (d) International Baccalaureate.

35 (2) (a) A school participating in the concurrent enrollment programs offered under
36 Section 53A-15-101 shall receive on a per student basis up to \$33.33 per quarter hour or \$50
37 per semester hour for each hour of higher education course work undertaken at the school.

38 (b) Each year the amounts specified in Subsection (2)(a) shall be adjusted in proportion
39 to the increase in the value of the weighted pupil unit from the prior year established in
40 Subsection 53A-17a-103(1).

41 (3) (a) Districts shall spend monies for these programs according to rules established
42 by the State Board of Education in accordance with Title 63, Chapter 46a, Utah Administrative
43 Rulemaking Act.

44 (b) The State Board of Education shall develop uniform and consistent policies for
45 school districts to follow in utilizing advanced placement and concurrent enrollment monies.

46 Section 2. **Effective date.**

47 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2007.
