Individual, Business and/or Local Impact

If this bill is enacted, individuals with Purple Heart license plates will no longer pay annual license and registration fees of \$24.50 to \$34.50, depending on county of residence.

Counties that currently collect the Local Corridor Preservation fee would experience a decrease in revenue equal to about \$4,300 annually.
