LONG TITLE
General Description:
This bill modifies the Motor Vehicles Code, the Revenue and Taxation Code, and the
State Boating Act by amending certain fee provisions.
Highlighted Provisions:
This bill:
<ul> <li>authorizes the Motor Vehicle Division to impose a fee on certain motor vehicle,</li> </ul>
off-highway vehicle, and boat registrations and renewals of registration to cover the
costs of electronic payments;
<ul> <li>authorizes the Motor Vehicle Enforcement Division to impose a fee on certain</li> </ul>
motor vehicle business transactions to cover the costs of electronic payments;
provides that the fees authorized:
<ul> <li>shall be imposed regardless of the method of payment;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>need not be separately identified; and</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>shall be used as nonlapsing dedicated credits;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>authorizes the State Tax Commission to charge convenience fees to cover the costs</li> </ul>
of electronic payments of taxes and fees administered by the commission and
provides that the fees shall be used as dedicated credits by the commission; and
<ul> <li>makes technical changes.</li> </ul>
