Mr. Speaker:

The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 32, EXPEDITED PARENT-TIME ENFORCEMENT**, by Representative Julie Fisher, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 42 through 46:*

- 42 (3) (a) [~~Under this pilot program, if~~] If a parent files a motion in the [~~third~~] district
43 court alleging that court-ordered parent-time rights are being violated, the clerk of the
 court,
44 after assigning the case to a judge, shall refer the case to the administrator of this [~~pilot~~]
45 program for assignment to a mediator, unless a parent is incarcerated or otherwise
 unavailable. **The director of the program for the courts, the court, or the mediator**
 may excuse either party from the requirement to mediate for good cause.
46 Unless the court rules otherwise, a parent residing outside of the state is not unavailable.
