Mr. Speaker:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 51**, ADOPTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative S. Allen, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Line 78 through Page 4, Line 90:
 - 78 (ii) subject to Subsection (3), the criminal history check described in Subsection (1)(b)(ii)(B) shall be submitted
 - in a manner acceptable to the court that will:
 - 80 (A) preserve the chain of custody of the results; and
 - 81 (B) not permit tampering with the results by a prospective adoptive parent or other
 - 82 interested party; and
 - 83 (b) if the adoption is being handled by a private attorney, and not a human services
 - program, the criminal history checks described in Subsection (1)(b)(ii), shall be:
 - 85 (i) submitted in accordance with procedures established by the Criminal Investigations
 - and Technical Services Division of the Department of Public Safety; or
 - 87 (ii) subject to Subsection (3), submitted in a manner acceptable to the court that will:
 - 88 (A) preserve the chain of custody of the results; and
 - 89 (B) not permit tampering with the results by a prospective adoptive parent or other 90 interested party.
 - (3) <u>In order to comply with Subsection (2)(a)(ii) or (b)(ii), the manner in which</u> the criminal history check is submitted shall be approved by the court.
