Mr. Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 162**, ILLEGAL DRUG SITES CONTAMINATION AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. Litvack, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 17:
 - 15 provides that if a report of contamination is made to a local health department by
 - 16 any party other than a law enforcement agency, the party must provide confirmation
 - 17 of the contamination by a certified decontamination specialist <u>and must cover the costs</u> of the contamination testing and report ; and
- 2. Page 2, Lines 53 through 56:
 - 53 (3) When the local health department receives a complaint or report of contamination
 - 54 <u>from a source other than a law enforcement agency, the local health department shall</u> <u>require</u>
 - 55 that the complaint or report be confirmed by a written chemical analysis of the site conducted
 - 56 <u>by a certified decontamination specialist.</u> <u>The chemical analysis and report shall be</u> paid for by the person submitting the complaint or report under this Subsection (3).
