NOTICE OF BILL TABLED

February 21, 2007

Mr. President:

The Health and Human Services Committee has tabled **3rd Sub. H.B. 163**, OPTIONS FOR HEALTH CARE, by Representative J. Dunnigan, with the following amendments and has returned it to the Rules Committee for filing.

- 1. Page 11, Lines 316 through 322:
 - 316 (c) An insurer may offer policies that provide that when an insured receives services
 - 317 <u>from a health care provider not under contract, the insurer:</u>
 - 318 (i) will reimburse the insured in an amount or percentage specified in the contract,
 - 319 however, that percentage may not be less than :
 - (A) 50% of the average amount paid by the insurer
 - 320 <u>for comparable services of preferred health care providers who are members of the same</u> class
 - of health care providers unless the illness or injury treated by the health care provider are not
 - within the scope of the insurance contract; and

(B) 75% of the average amount paid by the insurer for the treatment of an emergency medical condition as required under Section 31A-22-627;
