Mr. Speaker:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 169**, VIRTUAL CHARTER SCHOOLS, by Representative S. Urquhart, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 42 through 45:*

42           (2) "Virtual charter school" means a ~~{charter school that uses technology in~~  
43           ~~order to~~  
44           ~~provide a preponderance of its curriculum and instruction to its students through the~~  
45           ~~Internet or~~  
46           ~~other electronic means in a manner that fosters on-demand, interactive, self-paced,~~

48           ~~individualized instruction.}~~ performance-based, charter school that delivers  
49           synchronous or asynchronous instruction from a teacher to a student primarily  
50           through the use of technology via the Internet in a virtual or remote setting.

2. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 79:*

78           (b) The virtual charter school ~~{and the other public school shall enter into an~~  
79           ~~agreement~~  
80           ~~to cover the reasonable costs of participation in the program.}~~ shall remit to the  
81           other public school one-sixth of the value of the weighted pupil unit provided in  
82           Subsection 53A-17a-103(1) for each academic course that the virtual charter school  
83           student enrolls in at the other public school, up to a maximum of two courses.
