Mr. President:

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **3rd Sub. H.B. 277**, CONSTRUCTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. Morley, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 60 through 63:
- 60 {<u>(iii) For purposes of this determining final completion, the term "substantial</u> work"
- 61 <u>does not include:</u>
- 62 <u>(A) repair work; or</u>
- 63 <u>(B) warranty work.</u>}
- 2. Page 3, Lines 71 through 73:
 - 71 (c) For purposes of this {<u>section</u>} <u>chapter</u>, the term "substantial work" does not include:
 - 72 (i) repair work; or
 - 73 (ii) warranty work.
- 3. Page 7, Lines 183 through 187:
 - 183 (1) (a) (i) (A) For a construction project where a building permit is issued to an original
 - 184 contractor or owner-builder, within 15 days after the issuance of the building permit $\{\overline{,}\}$

- 185 government entity issuing that building permit shall input the building permit application and
- 186 transmit the building permit information to the database electronically by way of the Internet or

- 4. Page 7, Lines 197 through 203:
- (b) {For a construction project where a building permit is not issued,
 within } Within 15 days
- 198 after commencement of physical construction work at the project site, the original contractor or
- 199 owner-builder may file a notice of commencement with the database <u>if:</u>

(i) a building permit is not issued; or

(ii) a building permit is issued but a notice of commencement under Subsection (1)(a) is not obtained

- 200 {-(c) If a building permit is issued more than 15 days after commencement of physical
- 201 <u>construction work at the project site, a notice of commencement based on that building</u> <u>permit</u>
- 202 <u>is effective only as to a person who did not provide labor, service, equipment, or material</u>
- 203 <u>before the filing of the notice of commencement.</u>}
