The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 321**, OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. Noel, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 17 through 19:
 - 17 \(\) \(\{ \) \(\)
 - 18 certificate, or driver license operating requirement from { an infraction to a class C
 - 19 **misdemeanor** } **\$50 to \$100**;
- 2. Page 1, Line 22:
 - 22 law enforcement agency in certain circumstances;
 - <u>provides an exception to the off-highway vehicle accident notice</u>
 <u>requirement;</u>
- 3. *Page 3, Lines 62 through 63:*
 - 62 [(2)] (a) [Any] A person convicted of a violation of this section is guilty of $\{+\}$ an
 - 63 infraction and shall be fined not more than $\{\$50\}$ per offense $\{\}$ $\{$ a class C misdemeanor $\}$.
- 4. *Page 3, Lines 70 through 72:*
 - 70 [(3)] (4) The requirements of this section do not apply to an operator of all-terrain
 - 71 type I vehicle with a properly displayed and current and off-highway implement of husbandry
- 72 {sticker} .

- 5. Page 3, Line 83:
 - 83 (3) The provisions of Section 41-6a-402 apply to accidents reported under this section.

(4) The requirements of this section do not apply to an operator of an offhighway implement of husbandry if the off-highway implement of husbandry is being operated on public lands or designated trails.
