Mr. President:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 351**, REVOLVING LOAN FUND FOR CERTAIN ENERGY EFFICIENT PROJECTS, by Representative R. Barrus, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 15 through 16:*

- 15 {local} school districts;
16 ▶ establishes the revenue and use of the fund;

2. *Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 60:*

- 58 (4) (a) The board shall make loans from the fund only to {local} school
 districts to finance
59 energy efficiency projects in {local} school district buildings, including paying the
 costs of
60 construction, engineering, investigation, inspection, and other related expenses.

3. *Page 3, Lines 61 through 64:*

- 61 (b) The board may not:
62 (i) make loans from the fund to finance a school district's compliance with the energy
63 code in the construction of a new building; {or}
64 (ii) make a loan from the fund with a term of less than two years or more than 12
