Mr. President:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 351**, REVOLVING LOAN FUND FOR CERTAIN ENERGY EFFICIENT PROJECTS, by Representative R. Barrus, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 16:
 - 15 {**local**} school districts;
 - 16 establishes the revenue and use of the fund;
- 2. Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 60:
 - 58 (4) (a) The board shall make loans from the fund only to {local} school districts to finance
 - 59 <u>energy efficiency projects in</u> {<u>local</u>} <u>school district buildings, including paying the</u> <u>costs of</u>
 - 60 construction, engineering, investigation, inspection, and other related expenses.
- 3. Page 3, Lines 61 through 64:
 - 61 (b) The board may not:
 - 62 (i) make loans from the fund to finance a school district's compliance with the energy
 - 63 <u>code in the construction of a new building</u>; $\{-or\}$
 - 64 (ii) make a loan from the fund with a term of less than two years or more than 12

<u>years</u> <u>; or</u> (iii) make loans from the fund to any entity other than a school district</u>.

4. Page 5, Lines 136 through 136a House Committee Amendments 2-5-2007:

- 136 <u>There is appropriated</u> $\hat{H} \rightarrow \underline{\text{from the}} \{ \underline{\text{General}} \}$ <u>Uniform School</u> Fund $\leftarrow \hat{H}$ for fiscal year 2007-08 only,
- 136a <u>\$5,000,000 to the Energy Efficiency</u>
