Mr. Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 354**, BUS PASSENGER SAFETY ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. Walker, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. *Page 2, Lines 46 through 48:*

46 (b) The prohibition of Subsection (4)(a) does not apply to:
47 (i) { ~~elected or appointed peace officers or commercial security personnel who~~
are in
48 possession of weapons or firearms used in the course and scope of their
employment } individuals listed in Subsections 76-10-523(1)(a),(b),(c),(d), and
(e) [~~or~~];

2. *Page 3, Lines 70 through 72:*

70 (2) [~~Any~~] (a) A person who carries a concealed dangerous weapon, firearm, or any
71 { ~~explosive,~~ } highly inflammable or hazardous materials or devices into a terminal or
aboard a bus
72 [~~shall be~~] is guilty of a third degree felony.
