## Mr. President:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 62**, COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY TUITION TAX CREDITS, by Senator G. Bell, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 18:
  - ▶ establishes definitions, including eligibility for the credit;
  - 16 {→ requires the State Tax Commission to verify certain eligibility information with
  - 17 institutions of higher education; and
  - 18 gives rulemaking authority to the State Tax Commission.
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 37 through 38:* 
  - 37 (ii) is legally claimed as a personal exemption on the federal and state individual
  - income tax return of a claimant who has claimant's income of \$30,000 or less regardless of filing status;
- *3. Page 3, Lines 67 through 73:*

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- 67 <u>section if the amount of the tax credit exceeds the claimant's tax liability under this chapter.</u>
- 68 (b) {(i) Prior to issuing a refund for a refundable tax credit as provided in Subsection
- 69 (3)(a), the commission shall, at a minimum, verify enrollment and qualified higher education
- 70 <u>expense information with the eligible institution.</u>
- 71 (ii) Upon request of the commission, the eligible institution shall release requested
- 72 information, including applicable enrollment and qualified higher education expense
- 73 information  $\{ -\}$  to the commission for an eligible student.
