Mr. Speaker:

The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 98**, GOVERNMENTAL IMMUNITY FOR TRAILS, by Senator D. C. Buttars, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 26 through 27:
 - 26 the trail r
 - the trail right-of-way owner has a written agreement with the municipality or
 - 27 county opening the right-of-way to public use;
 - requires the written agreement to provide that the owner of the right-of-way where trail is located has the same level immunity as a governmental entity from suit in connection with or resulting from the use of the trail;
- 2. Page 5, Line 126:
 - 126 (iii) the written agreement :
 - (A) _ contains a plan for operation and maintenance of the trail; and
 - (B) provides that the owner of the right-of-way where trail is located has the same level immunity as a governmental entity from suit in connection with or resulting from the use of the trail;
- 3. Page 6, Line 167:
 - 167 (d) the written agreement :
 - (i) contains a plan for operation and maintenance of the trail {-} and
 - (ii) provides that the owner of the right-of-way where trail is

 located has the same level immunity as a governmental entity

 from suit in connection with or resulting from the use of the
