## Mr. President:

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 102**, MASTER PLUMBER LICENSING, by Senator S. Jenkins, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 13, Lines 384 through 388:
  - 384 (D) in addition to meeting the qualifications of Subsection (3)(a)(i)(A), (B), or (C),has
  - 385 <u>completed at least</u> { <u>one year of a postsecondary education course of study in business</u>,
  - 386 management, and finance in accordance with rules made by the division regarding:
  - 387 <u>(I) the number of required courses and course hours; and</u>
  - (II) the institutions or individuals qualified to offer and teach the

    courses

    inine semester hours of post secondary education or its equivalent in the

    areas of project supervision, construction accounting, business law, office

    management, or other business related courses approved by the Plumbers Licensing

    Board, except that a contractor who has held a license for at least five years in

    another trade in the state or in a state that is currently in good standing is exempt

    from this Subsection (3)(a)(i)(D) requirement.
