## Mr. President:

The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 197**, LOCAL INITIATIVE AND PETITION BALLOT TITLES, by Senator P. Knudson, with the following amendments and recommends it be considered read for the second time and placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 84:* 
  - 78  $\left[\frac{4}{6}\right]$  (a) If the ballot title furnished by the local attorney is unsatisfactory or does
  - 79 not comply with the requirements of this section, [at least three of the sponsors of the petition
  - 80 may, by motion, appeal] the decision of the local attorney may be appealed by a {motion} to the
  - 81 Supreme Court that is brought by:
  - 82 (i) at least three sponsors of the initiative petition; or
  - 83 (ii) a majority of the local legislative body for the jurisdiction where the initiative
  - 84 petition was circulated.

## 2. Page 5, Lines 131 through 137:

- [(4)] (6) (a) If the ballot title furnished by the local attorney is unsatisfactory or does
- not comply with the requirements of this section, [at least three of the sponsors of the petition
- 133 may, by motion, appeal] the decision of the local attorney may be appealed by a {motion} petition to the
