Mr. President:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 200**, REDUCED CIGARETTE IGNITION PROPENSITY, by Senator E. Mayne, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 60 through 71:
 - 60 (3) "Manufacturer" means <u>a tobacco product manufacturer as defined in</u> Section 59-22-202. {:
 - 61 <u>(a) any entity which:</u>
 - 62 (i) manufactures or otherwise produces cigarettes to be sold in the state;
 - 63 <u>(ii) causes cigarettes to be manufactured or produced anywhere with the intent</u> to sell in
 - 64 <u>the state; or</u>
 - 65 <u>(iii) manufactures or otherwise produces cigarettes or cause cigarettes to be</u>
 - 66 <u>manufactured or produced with the intent to sell in the United States through an</u> <u>importer;</u>
 - 67 <u>(b) the first purchaser anywhere that intends to resell in the United States</u> <u>cigarettes</u>
 - 68 <u>manufactured anywhere that the original manufacturer or maker does not intend to</u> <u>be sold in</u>
 - 69 <u>the United States; or</u>
 - 70 <u>(c) any entity that becomes a successor of an entity described in Subsection</u> (3)(a) or
 - 71 <u>(3)(b).</u>}
