#### H.B. 385 Process Server Amendments (Rep. L. Shurtliff)

- 1. Page 2, Lines 28 through 31:
  - 28 (1) Persons who are not peace officers, constables, sheriffs, or lawfully appointed
  - deputies of such officers, or authorized state investigators, or licensed private investigators may
  - 30 not serve any forms of civil or criminal process { other than complaints, summonses, and
  - 31 subpoenas .
