H.B. 162 Illegal Drug Sites Contamination Amendments *(Rep. D. Litvack)*

Rep. Litvack introduced the bill.

MOTION: Rep. Litvack moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 17:

15 ▶ provides that if a report of contamination is made to a local health department by
16 any party other than a law enforcement agency, the party must provide confirmation
17 of the contamination by a certified decontamination specialist **and must cover the costs**
of the contamination testing and report ; and

2. Page 2, Lines 53 through 56:

53 (3) When the local health department receives a complaint or report of contamination
54 from a source other than a law enforcement agency, the local health department shall

- require
55 that the complaint or report be confirmed by a written chemical analysis of the site
conducted
56 by a certified decontamination specialist. **The chemical analysis and report shall be**
paid for by the person submitting the complaint or report under this Subsection (3).

The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Dee and Rep. Morley absent for the vote.
