H.B. 162 Illegal Drug Sites Contamination Amendments (Rep. D. Litvack)

Rep. Litvack introduced the bill.

MOTION: Rep. Litvack moved to amend the bill as follows:

- 1. *Page 1, Lines 15 through 17:*
 - provides that if a report of contamination is made to a local health department by
 - any party other than a law enforcement agency, the party must provide confirmation
 - of the contamination by a certified decontamination specialist and must cover the costs of the contamination testing and report; and
- 2. Page 2, Lines 53 through 56:
 - 53 (3) When the local health department receives a complaint or report of contamination
 - 54 from a source other than a law enforcement agency, the local health department shall

<u>require</u>

- 55 that the complaint or report be confirmed by a written chemical analysis of the site conducted
- by a certified decontamination specialist. The chemical analysis and report shall be paid for by the person submitting the complaint or report under this Subsection (3).
