H.B. 110 State Fleet Efficiency Requirements (Rep. F. Hunsaker)

 - 110 (4) (a) [The] In accordance with Title 63, Chapter 46a, Utah Administrative
 - 111 Rulemaking Act, the { executive director of the Department of Administrative Services } director of the Division of Fleet Operations :

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112	(i) may make rules governing fuel dispensing [according to the procedures and
