 - 123 (b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a public body from utilizing a third party
 - 124 {<u>Internet</u>} service provider <u>or website</u> as the primary host for posting of public notices as required by this
 - 125 <u>chapter, provided that the public notice is easily accessible to citizens that use the Internet.</u>
